

BLACK MADONNA SUPPLY LIST

All you need for this painting process is acrylic paint (any colors you want to use), a canvas, water and brushes. Depending on what brands you get and what you have, your set up cost could be as low as \$35 or as high as \$200.

ACRYLIC PAINT

Our preferred choice is Golden Brand in the Fluid style squeeze bottles. Golden is high quality, great colors and easy to work with. (Heavy body is also a fine alternative to fluid style, it is simply thicker - a good choice for texture.) You can find other brands of paint at Michaels or other craft supply stores for as little as \$1.50 per tube.

You only need one shade of each color to set up your studio, and I don't use every single color listed below in the video series. These are just suggestions to get your paint studio set up. I have listed the GOLDEN brand colors, but again, just get one of each color in all the colors of the rainbow. Choose a variety based on your budget and the draw of what looks good to you. I suggest purchasing the colors have a * next to them if you want to glaze/tint your painting, they are the best colors for this technique - and my personal favorites.

SHILOH SUGGESTED COLORS

quinacridone nickel azo gold*
transparent red iron oxide*
white titanium
bone black
raw umber
burnt sienna
cadmium red
quinacridone magenta
quinacridone crimson
pyrrole orange
hansa yellow light
ultramarine blue
permanent violet dark
turquoise phthalo
cobalt turquoise
phthalo green
iridescent bright gold fine (or copper, silver, bronze)

BRUSHES

Minimum 5-25 assorted sizes (start with large & a medium sized hard-bristle Round, a medium sized Filbert, a small Flat and a Liner...add a Sash, fan, and other sizes that look good according to your budget. You are going to pay very different prices depending on where you shop. With brushes you DO get what you pay for so be mindful to check pricing.)

OTHER

Canvas (16X20 or what you have), Journal/Sketchpad and black charcoal pencils, Water Spray Bottle, jar for water, rags. Surface to work on or easel. Camera in case you want to take photos of your work at each phase.
